# NEW JUDGE AT THE COURT OF FIRST INSTANCE OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES

Formal sitting of 7 July 2004

In accordance with the provisions of the Treaty of Nice (which was signed on 26 February 2001 and entered into force on 1 February 2003) and the Act concerning the conditions of accession of the new Member States, the Representatives of the Governments of the Member States on 23 June 2004 adopted a decision appointing Verica TRSTENJAK, a Slovene national, a Judge of the Court of First Instance.<sup>1</sup>

The new Judge will enter into office upon taking the oath.

The formal sitting at which the new member will enter into office will be held at 12.30 on 7 July in the Grande Salle d'Audience (Main Court Room) of the Court of Justice (entrance from the Boulevard Konrad Adenauer, opposite the European Investment Bank).
