**VISIT BY A DELEGATION FROM THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF POLAND  
TO THE COURT OF JUSTICE OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES**

A delegation of 11 judges from the Constitutional Court of Poland, headed by its President, Mr Marek Safjan, paid an official visit to the Court of Justice of the European Communities on 10 and 11 October 2005. The delegation was received by Mr Vassilios Skouris, President of the Court, by Mr Jerzy Makarczyk, the Polish judge at the Court, and by Mr Roger Grass, Registrar of the Court.

A round table discussion on the role of the Court of Justice within the Community legal order and on the relations of the Court of Justice with the national constitutional courts was organised on the first day of the visit, and this was attended by the President of the Court of Justice and by other members.

On the second day of the visit, the delegation took part in working sessions dealing with proceedings before the Court of Justice, the linguistic regime of the Court, the organisation and work of the Translation Directorate and the activities of the Press and Information Service.

This meeting has been organised within the framework of the close, ongoing relations which the Court of Justice maintains with the superior courts of the Member States. The President of the Court of Justice had been received in July 2005 by the Constitutional Court of Poland.
