**VISIT BY A DELEGATION FROM THE SUPREME COURT OF THE CZECH  
REPUBLIC TO THE COURT OF JUSTICE OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES**

A delegation of six Members of the Supreme Court of the Czech Republic, led by its President, Ms Iva Brožová, paid an official visit to the Court of Justice of the European Communities on 9 and 10 October 2007. The delegation was welcomed by Mr Vassilios Skouris, President of the Court of Justice, Mr Jirí Malenovský, a Judge at the Court, and Mr Roger Grass, the Registrar of the Court.

The delegation took part in working sessions on the jurisdiction and organisation of the Court of Justice in which Mr Jirí Malenovský, a Judge at the Court, and Ms Irena Pelikánová, President of a Chamber of the Court of First Instance, participated.

A round table discussion was organised, in which the President of the Court of Justice and the Members of the Court of Justice participated, on 'The relationships between the Court of Justice and the national courts' and 'The increase in the number of cases and in the duration of proceedings'.

The delegation also took part in working sessions on the proceedings before the Court, the language arrangements of the Court and the organisation and work of the Translation Directorate-General.

The visit comes within the context of the continuous and close relations which the Court of Justice maintains with the supreme courts of the Member States.
